IBM® Tivoli® Storage Manager for Databases protects database management systems, such as Oracle and Microsoft SQL Server by backing up and restoring data.

3 Step 3: Installing Tivoli Storage Manager for Databases



Insert the product DVD into the DVD drive and complete these tasks for your operating system:

- For Microsoft Windows:
 - Data Protection for Microsoft Server: Double-click the `setup.exe` file and click **OK**. Follow the installation instructions.
 - Data Protection for Oracle: If autorun is enabled, the installation dialog starts automatically when the DVD is loaded. Otherwise, click **Start** > **Run** and enter `x:\setup` where `x` is the DVD drive. Click **OK**. Follow the installation instructions.
- For IBM AIX®: Log in by using the root user ID and enter the command `smitty install` at the command line. Press Enter and follow the installation instructions.
- For HP-UX Itanium, Linux, and Solaris SPARC: Log in by using the root user ID and enter the name of the installation file `file_name.bin` at the command line. Press Enter and follow the installation instructions.

4 Step 4: Configuring Tivoli Storage Manager for Databases
